 appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,
 taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

as provided in said contract for deed above referred to

and that she will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said party ies of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against
 said party ies of the first part, her heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the
 same.
