Kirshner, of Muskogee, Oklahoma, the following described real property and premises situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Five (5), Township Sixteen (16) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, of the Indian Base and Meridian, according to the Government survey thereof, Being a part of the allotment of Jackson Techarna, deceased Full blood Indian #2980.
