KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT James Constantine and Olive Constantine, husband and wife, of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereinafter referred to as First Party, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) cash in hand paid by EXCHANGE Trust COMPANY, a Corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereinafter called Trustee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of the debt and trust hereinafter mentioned, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said EXCHANGE TRUST COMPANY, Trustee, and to its successors in trust, the following described property, situate, lying and being in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of Lot Six (6) in Block One Hundred Sixty-four (164) of  
the Town, now City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the Government  
Plat and Survey thereof.
