202593 C. J. COMPARED DEED OF TRUST.

For and in consideration of one dollar to us paid, the receipt of which is acknowledged, and the other considerations hereinafter mentioned, we, R. F. Long, Trustee, for E. B. Long, and E. B. Long, have this day bargained and sold, and do hereby transfer and convey to J. B. Bell, Trustee and his successors in trust, certain property in the State of Oklahoma, Tulsa County, described as follows, to wit:

Being a lot located on Main Street in the City of Tulsa Oklahoma, said lot being the northerly fifty (50) feet of Lots Nos. two & Three (2 & 3) Block No. Sixty (60) according to the Government Survey and plat thereof of said town, which is recorded in said County. Making a plot of ground fifty (50) by one hundred and forty (140) feet, having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on Main Street, and located on said lot there are two brick store houses, two stories high, each,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said property to the said J. B. Bell, Trustee, and his successors in trust, forever. We covenant that we are lawfully seized of the said property, have a good right to convey it, and that the same is unincumbered, except as hereinafter stated. We further covenant and bind ourselves, our heirs and representatives, to warrant and defend the title to said property to the said J. B. Bell, Trustee, or his successor in trust, and his assigns, forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

But this conveyance is made in Trust for the following uses and trusts, and for no other purpose, to wit:

Long, and husband, W. J. Millard, are indebted to the Robertson County Bank & Trust Co. of Springfield, Tennessee, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of Tennessee, with its office in Springfield, Tennessee, for borrowed money in the sum of thirty thousand (\$30,000.00) dollars, for which they have executed their fifteen joint & several promissory notes for the sum of \$2,000.00 each, all payable to the order of the Robertson County Bank & Trust Company, at its office in Springfield, Tennessee, all bearing interest from date at six per cent per annum, said interest being due payable annually.
