WITNESSETH: That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part his successors and assigns, all the following described real estate, lying situate and being in the county of Tulsa State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A Part of Lot Three (3) in Block One Hundred Ten (110) of the original Town, now City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
