The Grantees herein are to assume all taxes on the within described lands.

To have and to hold the same unto the said L. G. Meyers and Nellie Meyers and unto their heirs and assigns forever; with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And I, Nettie Fallin wife of C. A.
