

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said mentioned tracts and parcels of land with the appurtenances thereunto belonging to said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, in as full and ample manner as the said Treasurer of said County if empowered by law to sell the same, and all taxes penalties, interest and cost accrued thereon for the year 1916, that being the year's tax for which said property was sold to said county, together with all taxes, penalties, interest and costs previously assessed or existing against said real estate, including paving taxes and outstanding tax sales certificates, are hereby cancelled and set aside, provided, that no taxes levied or assessed upon said property and for which the same became liable for payment since November 26th, 1919, shall be hereby affected and provided further, that the purpose of this deed is to correct and remedy any imperfections, defects or irregularities of the aforesaid deed by W. W. Stuckey, as County Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to said J. L. Heath under date of December 3rd 1919, which is recorded in Book 324 at page 175, in the office of the County Clerk within and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
