AGRICULTURAL LEASE

THIS LEASE, Made this 24th day of June, 1922, by and between Johnston Tiger of the first part and V. W. Miracle of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That said first party in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth does by these presents demise, lease and let unto the second party the following described property, situated in the County of Tulsa in the State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 10 East.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the second party from the 24th day of June 1922, to the 23d day of June, 1923. And said second party in consideration of the premises, herein set forth, agrees to pay to first part as rental for the above described premises the sum of Fifty and no/100 (\$50.00) Dollars.

And it is also agreed that upon the failure to pay the rentals or any part thereof as hereinafter provided, or to otherwise comply with the terms and conditions of this lease by the second party, then the first party may declare this lease at an end and void, and re-enter and take possession of said premises.

It is also further agreed by and between the parties hereto Fifty Dollars paid in hand

It is further agreed that at the end of this lease, or sooner termination thereof, the second party shall give peaceful possession of the premises to the first party in as good condition as they are now, the usual wear and tear damage by the elements alone excepted. And upon the non-payment of the rent, or any part thereof, at the time and in the manner hereinabove set forth, then the party of the first part may distrain for rent due and declare this lease at an end and void, and re-enter and recover possession by forcible entry and detainer, and notice of such election and demand for possession are hereby waived.

The covenants and agreements of this lease shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors and assigns of the parties hereto.
