#### ORDER CONFIRMING SALE OF REAL ESTATE.

An order having been made by this court on the 24th day of May, 1922, authorizing S. B. Allton, as the administrator of the Estate of Henry L. Dorr, deceased, to sell certain real estate, belonging to said estate, and afterward, to-wit, on the 19 day of June, 1922, S. B. Allton having made to this court, and filed in the office thereof, a return of his proceedings under the said order of sale and duly returned to this court an account of sales, verified by affidavit of the said S. B. Allton, this court, having examined the said return, and having in open court also examined the said S. B. Allton, and it appearing to the satisfaction of this court:

That in pursuance of said order of sale S. B.
