ORDER APPROVING FINAL REPORT AND DISCHARGING ADMINISTRATORS.

Be it remembered that on this the 8th day of January, 1920, this matter came on for hearing upon the final report and petition for discharge filed herein on December 11, 1919 by Oliver Bagby, Guy Patten and Louie G. Thomason, the Administrators of the Estate of John S. Thomason, deceased, and the court being advised in the premises finds that proper notice of this hearing has been given by publication in the Vinita Leader as provided by law and in accordance with the order of this court herein made, and the petitioners appearing in person and there being no objections made or filed to said report and no objection made to the application for discharge, and the court having heard the evidence and being fully advised in the premises finds that the estate has been fully administered, and that the administrators have fully accounted to the heirs of the estate for all funds belonging to them and that all debts and claims filed and allowed have been fully paid and discharged and that all duties to be performed in the premises by the administrators have been by them properly and fully performed.

That the heirs of the Estate are the widow, Rachel F. Thomason, a daughter, Bertha E. Gaston, and a son, Louie G. Thomason, all of whom are of full legal age, and it is therefore ordered and adjudged that the real estate and all personal property and estate belonging to said Estate, and wherever situate be and the same is vested in the said heirs in equal portions and interests, to each the undivided one-third.

And it is further adjudged by the court that the administration over this estate be and the same is terminated, and the administrators, Oliver Bagby, Guy Patten and Louie G. Thomason be discharged and released from further liability in the premises.

It is therefore ordered that the letters issued herein to said administrators be and the same are hereby vacated, and the said administrators and each and all of them are hereby finally discharged as such, and the bond made by them as such administrators and filed herein August 21, 1917 in the penal sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars for the faithful performance of the duties of administrators of this Estate, with United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company of Baltimore, Md. as surety, be and the same is hereby absolved from liability and fully released from future liability herein and fully exonerated and discharged.
