THIS INDENTURE, Made this 10th day of October, A. D. 1922, between

of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, part V of the first part, and

Philip Kates

of Tulsa part V of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said part V of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three thousand three & No/100 (\$3300.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do ss by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part V of the second part his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 195 feet West of the point where the west line of the North and South dedicated roadway intersects the north line of the east and West dedicated roadway said roadways being on the East and south line respectively of the north half of the northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section 18 Tp. 19 N. R. 13 E. thence running North from said point of beginning 315 feet thence west 155 feet:- thence 315 feet thence East 155 feet to place of beginning.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining forever.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of one promissory note of even date herewith. One for \$ 3300.00 due October 10th, 1923, 1922

or order, payable at Tulsa after maturity with 10 per cent interest per annum, payable semi-annually and signed by W. W. Henry

Said first part V hereby covenant S that he is owner in fee simple of said premises and that they are free and clear of all incumbrances except 7500 Mtge.

That he has good right and authority to convey and encumber the same, and he will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. Said first part S to insure the buildings on said premises in the sum of \$ 10,000.00 for the benefit of the mortgagee and maintain such insurance during the existence of this mortgage. Said first part S to pay all taxes and assessments lawfully assessed on said premises before delinquent.

Said first part V further expressly agree S that in case of foreclosure of this mortgage, and as often as any proceeding shall be taken to foreclose same as herein provided, the mortgagor will pay to the said mortgagee two hundred fifty Dollars as attorney's or solicitor's fees therefor, in addition to all other statutory fees; said fee to be due and payable upon the filing of the petition for foreclosure and the same shall be a further charge and lien upon said premises described in this mortgage, and the amount thereon shall be recovered in said foreclosure suit and included in any judgment or decree rendered in action as aforesaid, and collected, and the lien thereof enforced in the same manner as the principal debt hereby secured.

Now if said first part V shall pay or cause to be paid to said second part his heirs or assigns said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon according to the terms and tenor of said note and shall make and maintain such insurance and pay such taxes and assessments then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void, otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. If said insurance is not effected and maintained, or if any and all taxes and assessments which are or may be levied and assessed lawfully against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid before delinquent, then the mortgage S may effect such insurance or pay such taxes and assessments and shall be allowed interest thereon at the rate of 10 per cent per annum, until paid, and this mortgage shall stand as security for all such payments; and if said sum or sums of money or any part thereof is not paid when due, or if such insurance is not effected and maintained or any taxes or assessments are not paid before delinquent, the holder of said note and this mortgage may elect to declare the whole sum or sums and interest thereon due and payable at once and proceed to collect said debt including attorney's fees, and to foreclose this mortgage, and shall become entitled to possession of said premises.

Said first part V waive notice of election to declare the whole debt due as above and also the benefit to stay, valuation or appraisal laws.
