Said first part 1st hereby covenant _____ that they are owner S in fee simple of said premises and that they are free and clear of all incumbrances _____

That they have good right and authority to convey and encumber the same, and

the y will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. Said first part _____ agree _____ to insure the buildings on said premises in the sum of \$ 5000.00 for the benefit of the mortgagee and maintain such insurance during the existence of this mortgage. Said first part 1st agree _____ to pay all taxes and assessments lawfully assessed on said premises before delinquent.

If said insurance is not effected and maintained, or if any and all taxes and assessments which are or may be levied and assessed lawfully against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid before delinquent, then the mortgagee _____ may effect such insurance or pay such taxes and assessments and shall be allowed interest thereon at the rate of 10 per cent per annum, until paid, and this mortgage shall stand as security for all such payments; and if said sum or sums of money or any part thereof is not paid when due, or if such insurance is not effected and maintained or any taxes or assessments are not paid before delinquent, the holder of said note _____ and this mortgage may elect to declare the whole sum or sums and interest thereon due and payable at once and proceed to collect said debt including attorney's fees, and to foreclose this mortgage, and shall become entitled to possession of said premises.
