THIS INDENTURE, Made this 21st day of May, A. D. 1923, between \_\_\_\_\_

WITNESSETH, That said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Two hundred Eighty and 77/100 Dollars,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part 2nd of the second part its heirs  
and assigns, all the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County and State of  
Oklahoma, to-wit:

Eight (38), West Tulsa Addition to the city of Tulsa,

Said first part 1st hereby covenant that they owner 9 in fee simple  
of said premises and that they are free and clear of all incumbrances \_\_\_\_\_

That they have good right and authority to convey and encumber the same, and  
\_\_\_\_\_ will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. Said first part 1st agree \_\_\_\_\_ to insure the buildings on said  
premises in the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ for the benefit of the mortgagee and maintain such insurance during the existence of this mortgage. Said first part 1st  
agree \_\_\_\_\_ to pay all taxes and assessments lawfully assessed on said premises before delinquent.

be allowed interest thereon at the rate of 8 per cent per annum, until paid, and this mortgage shall stand as security for all such payments; and if  
said sum or sums of money or any part thereof is not paid when due, or if such insurance is not effected and maintained or any taxes or assessments are not paid before
