

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

Naylor paying his prorata part of the equipment in a gas well now on said premises, and for the shutting in of same.

and his heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and their heirs, successors and representatives do covenant with the said assignee, his heirs, successors or assigns, that they are the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due an payable thereunder have been duly paid.
