Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

WHEREAS, On the 3rd day of July 1920, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between Emma Johnson and Mollie Johnson, both single women, Lessor, and J. C. Leaw, Lessee, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto R. J. St Germain, an undivided one-third of the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the said interest in all the above lands

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to R. J. St. Germain and his heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for himself and his heirs, successors and representatives, do covenant with the said assignee, his heirs, successors or assigns, that he is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due an payable thereunder have been duly paid.
