Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

WHEREAS, On the 15th day of June 1922, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between Walter M. Stunkard and Elizabeth A. Stunkard, his wife, Lessor, and A. D. McDonell and C.R. Travers, Lessee, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter (NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Six (6), Township Eighteen North (18) Range Thirteen East (13)

Said lease being recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County in Book 349, page 311, and, WHEREAS, The said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto are now owned by J. P. Peterson

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto Arthur Baker, W. H. Hendee and J. R. Fugua, each 13/64 of all right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the undivided thirteen sixty-fourths of said specifically described lease to each, it being the intent and purpose to herein convey a total undivided interest of thirty-nine-sixty-fourths together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to Arthur Baker, W. H. Hendee and J. R. Fugua, 13/64ths, each and their heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for himself and his heirs, successors and representatives do covenant with the said assignee, their heirs, successors or assigns, that he is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
