

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

WHEREAS, On the 9th day of March 1923, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between Anna Hahn and Christoph Hahn, husband and wife of Bixby, Oklahoma, Lessor, and W. M. Reedy of Tulsa, Oklahoma, Lessee, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto The Texas Company, a corporation of Texas, all

the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the Southwest Quarter (SW1) of the Northeast Quarter (NE1), and the Northwest Quarter (NW1) of the Southeast Quarter (SE1) of Section Twenty (20), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to The Texas Company, a corporation of Texas and its heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and his heirs, successors and representatives do covenant with the said assignee, their heirs, successors or assigns, that he is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due an payable thereunder have been duly paid.
