

## Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

Hall, lessees, covering the following described land in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 33, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, containing 80 acres.

right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the one-thirty-second interest in all of the said leases hereinbefore described,

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to

to L. L. Boyd and his heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for himself and his heirs, successors and representatives, do ss covenant with the said assignee, his heirs, successors or assigns, that he is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due an payable thereunder have been duly paid.
