

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner, S, of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto Mid-State Petroleum Corporation all of their right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner, S, in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the above described premises and leasehold.

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to Mid-State Petroleum Corporation

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and their heirs, successors and assigns, do covenant with the said assignee, it's heirs, successors or assigns, that they are the lawful owner, S, of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid. and will warrant and defend the title to said property and chattels hereby sold, unto the said assignee, its successors and assigns, against all and every person whomsoever.
