

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and their heirs, successors and assigns.

representatives, do covenant with the said assignee, its heirs, successors or assigns, that the lawful owner, S. of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid, and will warrant and defend the title to said property and chattels hereby sold, unto the said assignee, its successors and assigns, against all and every person whomsoever.
