

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

of all right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the two sixty-fourths undivided interest in and to said described lease, it being the intent and purpose to convey herein two-sixty-fourths undivided interest in said forty acres.

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to

and his heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for him and his heirs, successors and representatives, do hereby covenant with the said assignee, his heirs, successors or assigns, that he is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
