all of the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the N 1/2 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and Lot 1 of Section 4-19N-11E, 40.64 acres

a like interest in together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to Skelly Oil Company

and its heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for and on behalf of the said assignee, heirs, successors or assigns, that the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
