

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

WHEREAS, On the 25th day of November 1908, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between F. M. Bussey Guardian for Millard F. Bussey, Lessor, and Henry Oil Company of Chicago, Illinois, Lessee, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner, of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto Alko Drilling Company

all

of their right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the South Half of the Southeast Quarter Sec. 9, Twp. 21, Rge. 14. All oil rights and the gas rights below fourteen hundred foot (1400) depth from the surface, provided the Coffeyville Vitrified Brick & Tile Co., have the option to purchase all gas produced below this level at ten cents (10¢) per thousand cubic feet, based on one pound pressure per square inch, delivered at the well, and it is also provided that in case gas is found in merchantable quantities above the fourteen hundred foot (1400) level, the Coffeyville Vitrified Brick & Tile Company are to have the option of taking over said gas well and to pay the actual expense of drilling said well to that depth.
