Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

of their right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner, in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Seven (7), and the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section Six (6), all in Township Sixteen (16) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma,
