

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

of its right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the an undivided three-fourths (3/4) interest in the oil and gas mining lease above described

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to E. A. Jacobson

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for himself and its heirs, successors and assigns, that it is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due an payable thereunder have been duly paid.
