Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

R. 13 E. consisting of 70 acres more or less.

Said lease being recorded in the office of the County Clerk in and for said County in Book 417, page 555, an undivided 1/8th interest of WHEREAS/The said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto are now owned by UNION DRILLING COMPANY

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto Wm. E. Stonebreaker, an undivided One Thirty-second Interest

of the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the above described lands. It is the intention by this instrument to assign Wm. E. Stonebreaker an undivided 1/32nd interest of the entire leasehold estate above referred to.

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to Wm. E. Stonebreaker and his heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for itself and its heirs, successors and representatives, do covenant with the said assignee, his heirs, successors or assigns, that it is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due an payable thereunder have been duly paid.
