

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

WHEREAS, On the 17th day of November 1923, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between Samuel Cupps, a widower, of Alsoma, Oklahoma, Lessor, and Brooks Drilling Co. Lessee, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, and containing One Hundred Sixty Acres (160) more or less.

Said lease being recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County in Book _____, page _____, and, WHEREAS, The said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto are now owned by Brooks Drilling Co.

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner, of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto Flesher Petroleum Company all its right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the South-west quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, and containing Eighty (80) acres more or less, together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to Flesher Petroleum Company and its heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for itself and its heirs, successors and representatives, do hereby covenant with the said assignee, its heirs, successors or assigns, that it is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due an payable thereunder have been duly paid.
