

## Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 409

Striker

all of our right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner, S. in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the undivided Five Sixteenths (5/16) interest in and to said lease and leasehold estate together with all oil wells, casing, pumps, pipe, tanks, equipment and all personal property on said lease or used in connection therewith on the above described land to John H. Striker

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for ourselves and our heirs, successors and assigns, do covenant with the said assignee, and heirs, successors or assigns, that we the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due an payable thereunder have been duly paid.
