

to be completed within ninety days shall prove to be productive of Oil. Then second party is to pay first party the sum of \$500.00 as a bonus. Said amount to be placed in First Nat. Bank of Collinsville, Okla., in escrow at the time well is spudded in and to be drawn by first party if said well is productive of oil otherwise to be drawn by second party.

It is agreed that the second party is to have the privilege of using sufficient water, oil and gas from the premises to run all necessary machinery, and at any time to remove all buildings, machinery and fixtures placed on said premises.

All provisions hereof shall extend to the heirs and assigns of the respective parties hereto.
