The south-west-quarter (1/4) of the south-east-quarter (1/4) of the north-east-quarter (1/4) of section sixteen (16), Township Twenty (20), North, Range-forteen (14) East of the Tundra Highway, in Tilden County, Oklahoma, containing ten (10) acres more or less according to the old survey thereof.

Party of the award post-humy agree with the party of the first part to drill and pump out gas and all other minerals, including coal, asphaltum and to develop either of said oil, gas or minerals on said above described land within twelve months from the date of signing this award contract. And the consideration of this deal and the performance of this contract is that the party of the second part shall render unto the first party trucking and one half (12 1/2) per cent of the gross proceeds of the said oil, gas, wells and mineral fractions; and a settlement shall be made at the end of every calendar quarter of the year.
