 Olive Oil Company. into this 21 day of November A.D.
 1907 by and between Wesley C. Baker and : of Collinsville,
 Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Olive Oil Company
 a Corporation of Tulsa Ok. organized and doing bus-
 iness under and by virtue of the laws of the United
 States in force in the Indian Territory, Party of
 the second part :

Witnesseth that the said Party of the first part
 for and in consideration of the covenants and agree-
 ments hereinafter inserted, and the sum of eight
 thousand one hundred seventy five (\$8175⁰⁰) Dollars in
 hand and hereby acknowledged, has granted, devised
 and let unto the Party of the second part, its successors
 and assigns, for the purpose and exclusive right of
 drilling and operating for and procuring oil and gas,
 all on the following described property, to wit:

East half of Southwest quarter of Section Nine, Town-
 ship Twenty one, Range thirteen (Cherokee Nation)
 Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to any extent the said
 Party of the second part may deem advisable, together
 with the right to lay, erect and maintain all neces-
 sary pipe and pipe lines, tanks, structures, roads,
 cables and all other fixtures and machinery used
 in drilling for, pumping, preserving, storing and
 transporting the product on said premises.

The Party of the second part shall further have the
 right of using sufficient water from the premises
 for operating purposes and if necessary the right to
 drill for it on said premises.

The Party of the second part to have and to hold the
 premises for and during a term of fifteen years from
