Contract Agreement

This agreement, made and entered into and subscribed to by the approval of the County Board of Cherokee County, Oklahoma, - by and between Horace B. Johnson, guardian of Hugh Johnson, a minor - party of the first part, and The Henry Oil Company - a corporation, - party of the second part, Whereas, That whereas, under date of 19th day of February, 1905 the party of the first part executed and delivered to the party of the second part, said order and in pursuance to the order of said Court, an oil and gas saving lease covering the following described lands in Tulsa County, (formerly Cherokee Nation) Oklahoma to wit: $1\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 17, township 21 north, range 14 east, containing 80 acres, the same being a portion of the southeast of said minor in said Cherokee Nation, and Whereas, said lease constituted is a successful lease, operated in consideration of \$2500.00 since, ten per cent oil royalty, and the following agreement in reference to gas, to wit: \$1.00 per year per well when utilized and \$2.00 per year per well when closed-in; and whereas, said lease has been operated and the lease is in force in the State of Oklahoma and in conformity to the interpretation thereof by the Circuit Court of Appeal sitting at St. Louis, Missouri, and whereas, the said in interpreting said lease in reference to leasing may be appealed and reversed.
