

and King himself, or his successors in office, that in the event the existing lease is interrupted by the Board should be changed in the manner herein set forth, and which change should effect in every manner the legality of said contract of lease as decided herein, that he will at such time and at the request of the second party make, grant and deliver to said second party, his heirs, successors, or assigns, a good and valid oil and gas mining lease, covering said lands belonging to said minor, for the same or legally, heirs and assigns as expressed in said former lease, which said lease shall conform in all respects to the laws existing at the time same is made, provides it be more necessary for the making of such lease. It is further agreed, the parties have herunto set their hands and seals this the day and year first above written.
