This agreement, made between Thomas S. Johnson,
 guardian of Ray Johnson, a minor, party of the
 first part and the Henry Oil Company, a
 corporation under the laws of south Dakota -
 main office - Chicago - party of the second part.
 Witnesseth: That the party of the first part, in
 consideration of two hundred ten (\$210) dollars, the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and
 the covenant hereinafter contained on the part
 of the said party of the second part - does hereby lease
 unto the party of the second part the exclusive
 right for five years from date hereof to enter
 upon, operate for and operate oil and gas upon
 the following premises, situated in Butte county,
 Oklahoma, to-wit: The NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 sec. 10
 town 21 N. Range 14 E. sec. 10. The NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the
 SW 1/4 sec. 16 town 21 N. Range 14 E. sec. 10. The SE 1/4 of the
 NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 sec. 16, town 21 N. Range 14 E. sec. 20
 containing exactly seven more or less. The party
 of the second part agrees to deliver to the party of
 the first part 10 per cent of the oil saved from
 the premises, in tank, at the well without
