If said first well is not a producer of oil in paying quantities, then said second party is to pay said first party the sum of eight hundred (\$800.00) dollars as a bonus, on or about and in least, said amount to be placed in the First National Bank of Baltimore, Maryland. In case the said first well to be completed within ninety (90) days, shall prove to be productive of oil in paying quantities, then said second party is to pay said first party the sum of eight hundred (\$800.00) dollars as a bonus, on or about and in least, said amount to be placed in the First National Bank of Baltimore, Maryland. In case now, at the time said well is completed in and to be drawn by first party if said well produces oil in paying quantities, then said second party is to draw by said second party.

It is agreed, that the second party is to have the privilege of using sufficient water, oil or gas, from the premises to run all necessary machinery and at any time to remove all buildings, machinery and fixtures placed on said premises. All provisions hereof shall extend to the heirs, successors and assigns of the respective parties hereto.
