In the matter of the ab-
sorption of water flowing
a citizen by flood of the
Christian Nation for the re-
moval of the restrictions upon
the sale of the allotment
except the home stead.

In accordance with the regulations approved by the
Secretary of the Interior, May 12, 1904 in conformity to the pro-
visions of the Act of Congress approved April 21, 1904 (33
Stat. 204). That made a full investigation in connection
with the application of Walter O'Connor, a citizen by flood
of the Christian Nation for the removal of the restrictions
upon the alienation of his allotment (except the home stead)
and as the result of that investigation advised that
the removal of restrictions upon the alienation of his
allotted lands except as to his homestead will be in
the best interest of the allottee and is recommended.

The approval of this circular does not in any
manner determine the right of the allottee to any
particular tract of land.
