 English & others { The agreement made the 5th day of
 November 1914 and December 18th 1917 between the English and
 M. A. English his wife, of Shiloh Indian Territory, of
 Western District Texas and J. H. Summers and R. A.
 Stindberg of Shiloh Indian Territory, Western District
 Texas.
 It is recited, that the Lessee in consideration of One (\$100) and
 no other value the right of which is hereby acknowledged and of
 other valuable considerations at hereby demise and grant
 unto the Lessee all the oil, gas and other minerals in and
 under the following described tract of land, and also the
 said tract of land for the surface and with the exclusive
 right of operating thereon for oil, gas and other minerals
 together with the right of way, right to lay pipe lines over
 and to use water from the premises, and also the right
 to erect and remove at any time all property placed thereon
 the leased tract of land is situated in the Western
 District, State of Texas.
 The west one half of the north west quarter of the northwest
 quarter of the north west quarter, of section twenty three (23)
 Township twenty-two (22) Range twelve east of the Canadian
 Meridian, in Indian Territory and containing five acre
 more or less according to Government survey.
 Also the south three and 26/30 acres, more or less of lot number
 two in section twenty-three (22) Township twenty-two (22) Range
 twelve east and according to plat and survey thereof
 containing of eight and 1/33 acre more or less. To have and to hold
 the same unto the Lessee for the term and period of five years
 from the date hereof and as much longer as oil, gas or other
 minerals are found in paying quantities thereon
