Order of Confirmation.

It appearing to the Court as a hearing on the 4th day of May, 1905, that on the 10th day of April, 1905, Emily M. Campbell, executrix in the above entitled case, filed her petition in the Court, praying for the confirmation of the will of the said decedent and,

It further appearing to the Court that on the said 10th day of April, 1905, the Court made an order setting the 4th day of May, 1905, for the hearing of said petition; and in said order required the petitioner to be present at the said hearing for a period of two days previous to the said 4th day of May, 1905, and,

It further appearing to the Court that in and to the honor of the will of the above named decedent, the said will having been admitted to probate in this court on the 10th day of December, 1904, the executrix, Emily M. Campbell, the petitioner aforesaid, was authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all of the real estate of said decedent as to her seemed fit and proper and,

It further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said will, the said executrix, Emily M. Campbell, sold to R. C. Allen for nine (\$9) in cash for (\$2) of the sum added to the City of Dubuque, Dubuque for the sum of \$350.00, and

It further appearing to the Court that in and to the mode of sale was required by said will of the said decedent and that said sale was legally
