

Oil and gas lease

Tr. of acres $3\frac{1}{2}$ description of land, all in 17-18-12. Creek
Native.

These Indentures of Lease, made and executed in the
in triplicate, on this 11th day of April A. D. 1905, by
and between John P. Solis, President of the
West of Louisiana Group of Landholders, Abbe, party of the
first part, lessor, and Fisking Oil Company of
Tulsa, Abbe, party of the second part, lessee.
Witnesseth, that, the party of the first part, for
and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
dollars, cash here, and the covenants, covenants,
stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained,
and hereby agreed to be paid, shewed and
performed by the party of the second part, its
successors and assigns, shew hereby giving,
grant and letting to the party of the second
part, its successors and assigns, for the term
of thirty years from the date hereof, not,
however, beyond the majority of said minor,
all of the oil, oil pits and natural gas, in or
under the following described tract of land,
lying and being within the County of Tulsa,
State of Oklahoma, to wit:

North half of southeast quarter of southeast quarter,
and southeast quarter of southeast quarter of
southeast quarter, & north half of southeast quarter
of southeast quarter of southeast quarter, &
southeast quarter of southeast quarter of southeast
quarter of southeast quarter of section 17, township

18 N. Range 12 E. situated in what is known as
Creek Nation containing $37\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, with
the right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store, refine and
remove such oil and natural gas, and to seep and
use so much only of the surface of said land as
may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work of
prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, refining
and removing such oil and natural gas, including
