 deposes and says: That she is the wife of C. H. Hatcher, Jr. and that the following described property, which is the subject of a mortgage executed by C. H. Hatcher, Jr. this day to Charles Page is no part of the homestead of said C. H. Hatcher, Jr. or myself, and that all homestead, exemption and stay laws are hereby expressly waived in respect to said mortgage, to wit: Fifty (50) feet off the north side of Lot one (1), Block 135, the same fronting fifty (50) feet on main Street, and having a frontage of 140 feet on west fourth (4th) street, and having a uniform width of fifty (50) feet from main Street to the alley, running through said block north and south.
