

and, in block 2 all of lot 3, in block 11 more fully described as follows: As to part of lot 15, block 11: Beginning at the northern point of lot 15, block 11, thence running southeasterly, along line between lots 3 and 4 and lot 15, 183.8 feet, thence southwesterly, parallel to and 122 feet distant from line between lots 4 and 15, to block line, thence north, along block line, to place of beginning, in the town of North Tulsa, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid.

In witness whereof, I, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown. 55
