

judgment for any statutory lien claims, and may interest such sums as may be necessary to protect the title or possession of said premises including all costs, and for the repayment of all moneys so expended together with the charges thereon as provided by the Constitution and by laws of the said associations, their parents and their security.

And whereas, the said The Trust and the wife, All Trust act on the 20th day of April 1905, make and deliver to the Farm and Horse Shavings and Horse Association of Wisconsin their note or obligation, which is made a part hereof and is inserted and figures as follows, to wit:

Note or Obligation

Wanda, Mr. April 20th 1905

For value received we promise to pay to the Farm and Horse Shavings and Horse Association of Wisconsin, the following sum of money, viz: the sum of eight dollars, the same being the monthly dues on the 1st day of the said stock of said Association, reported and evidenced by the certificate thereof, numbered 7997 this day signed by us to said Association to secure a loan of fifteen hundred and no dollars and the sum of nine dollars, the same being the interest due monthly upon said sum as borrowed by us and the sum of two dollars, the same being the premium due monthly upon said sum as borrowed, and we promise to pay said Association at the Home Office at Wanda, Wis. all of said sum of money, amounting in the aggregate thing dollars, on the 20th day of each and every month, and continue such monthly payments
