

(Power of Attorney)

Know all men by these presents, that I, Lane Company, of Oguston Oklahoma, party of the first part, have this day made, constituted and appointed and do hereby make, constitute and appoint all should of Mine Roger W. Lee Oklahoma party of the second part, my lawful agent and attorney in fact to act for me and in my name, place and stead in the transaction of the following business, that is to say, to lease, let or rent the following described land which has been allotted to me by authority of the United States, which land is described as follows to wit:

The northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section thirty one (31) township nineteen (19) north and range twelve (12) east.

Said party of the second part is authorized to lease said land for agricultural purposes and then or here in or for as the laws of the United States and those now existing in the state of Oklahoma permit.

Now said Lane may execute permits at any time during the continuance in force of this power of attorney and said party of the second part is authorized to sign any name to any and all instruments of writing necessary to the consummation of the business aforesaid, and to do and perform any and all other acts and things necessary to the accomplishment of the same as I could lawfully do if personally present and acting. In consideration of the payment of one dollar and other good and valuable consideration by the party of the second part to the party of the first part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, it is understood and agreed that this power of attorney shall be in full and effect for and during
