

Power Of Attorney.

Know all Men By These Presents:

That I, J. J. Dye, in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint G. T. Brown, of Tulsa, my true and lawful Attorney for me, and in my name, place and stead and to my use to assign and deliver to E. L. Fox of Tulsa, all tax warrants which may hereafter be issued to me by the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma in payment for the construction of sewers in Sewer District Nos. 4, 12 and 13 of said City of Tulsa giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform every act and thing whatsoever necessary and requisite to be done in the premises, as I might or could do if personally present.
