State of Oklahoma | In the County Court.
 County of Tulsa | Order confirming sale of
 Oil & Gas Mining Lease.
 In re Guardianship of Thomas Panther a
 minor, Amos W. Lord, Curator

Probate No. 113.

An order having been made by the Court on the 25th day of April 1908, authorizing Amos W. Lord, as curator of the estate of Thomas Panther a minor, to sell an oil and gas mining lease upon the allotment of the said minor ward and afterwards to wit on the 18th day of May 1908 Amos W. Lord having made to this Court and filed in the office thereof a return of his proceedings under the said order of sale and duly returned to this Court an account of sales verified by the affidavit of said Amos W. Lord this Court having examined the said return and having in open court also examined said Amos W. Lord and it appearing to the satisfaction of this Court.

That in pursuance of said order of sale Amos W. Lord caused notice of the time and place of holding said sale to be posted up in three of the most public places in said County in which the land ordered to be sold is situated and to be published in the Tulsa Democrat, a newspaper published and published in the same County for three weeks successively next before such sale, in which notice the oil and gas mining lease to be sold was described with common certainty.

That at the time and place of holding such sale specified in said notice said Amos W. Lord caused to be sold at Public Auction
