

Order of Confirmation

It appearing to the Court at a hearing on the 6th day of June 1908, that on the 2nd day of May 1908, Emily M. Campbell, executrix in the above entitled cause filed her petition, in this Court praying for the confirmation of the sale of the land herein described and

It further appearing to the Court that on the said 2nd day of May 1908, the Court made an order setting the 6th day of June 1908 for the hearing of said petition, and in said order required the publication of notice of said hearing for a period of ten day previous to the said 6th day of June 1908, and

It further appearing to the Court that under the terms of the will of the above named decedent the said will having been admitted to probate in this Court on the 10th day of December 1907, the executrix Emily M. Campbell the petitioner, aforesaid was authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all of the real estate of said decedent as to her 2nd fit and proper and, It further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said will the said executrix Emily M. Campbell sold to J. E. Moore Lot ten (10) in Block One (1) of the George B. Cowgman addition to Tulsa Oklahoma, for the sum of \$600.00 and

It further appearing to the Court that no special mode of sale was required by said will of the said decedent and that said sale was legally made and fairly conducted and that the sum paid was more than 90%
