

Tulsa Oklahoma for the sum of \$1000 and
 It further appearing to the court that
 no special mode of sale was required
 by said will of the said decedent and
 that said sale was legally made and
 fairly conducted that the sum paid
 was more than 90% of the appraised
 value of said lot; and that no greater sum
 than above specified could be obtained
 and; It further appearing to the court
 that the said executrix filed her petition
