Power of Attorney

Know all men by these presents, that I, Charles Dittler of Woodbury, in the County of Cherokee, and State of Oklahoma have made, constituted, and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute, and appoint James O. Ward, of Hollisville, Okla., my true and lawful attorney for me, and in my name, place and stead, and to my use, to rent or lease for grazing or agricultural purposes the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the lot 1 place known as tract 13 east of the Indian Meridian containing 3 acres more or less according to a printed survey for my time I might select or lease some tract all rents and benefits accruing therefrom to exercise a general exemption thereof and to take full possession thereof at any time I might otherwise take such possession myself - giving my said attorney full power to do every thing whatever, requisite and necessary to be done in the premises, as fully as I could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, such satisfying and conforming all that my said attorney or his substitutes, shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, by virtue hereof.
