

highest and best sum bid, that said sale was
 legally made and fair - concluded that said sum
 is not disproportionate to the value of the property sold
 and that a sum exceeding such bid at least ten (10)
 per cent exclusion of the expense of a new sale cannot
 be obtained, and that the said Samuel E. Jones,
 guardian in all things proceeded and conducted
 and managed such sale as required by the statute
 in such case made and provided, and do hereby
 order of sale required and directed.
 It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the
 Court, that the said sale be, and the same be
 fully confirmed and affirmed, and ordered validly
 and the said Samuel E. Jones, guardian of former
 John, minor, is directed to execute to said purchaser
 proper and legal conveyance of said real estate.
