Witnesseth that the said parties of the first
 part for and in consideration of the sum
 of One Dollar to him in hand well and
 truly paid by the said parties of the second
 part the receipt of which is hereby ack-
 nowledged and of the covenants and
 agreements hereinafter contained on the
 part of the said parties of the second part
 to be paid, kept and performed has
 granted, demised, leased and let and
 by these presents does grant demise
 lease and let unto the said parties of the
 second part, their heirs administrators
 executors successors or assigns for the
 sole and only purpose of mining and
 operating for oil and gas and of laying pipe
 lines and of building tanks, stations, and
 structures thereon to take care of said
 products all that certain tract of land
 situate in the Western District of the
 Indian Territory hereby releasing and
 waiving all rights under and by virtue
 of the homestead exemption laws bounded
 substantially as follows: The north-half
 (1/2) of the south-west quarter (1/4) of Section
 sixteen (16) and the south-west quarter
 of the south-east quarter of Section sixteen
